- There is a prescription drug drop box located at the Dighton Police Station. It is limited to pill form prescriptions only. You may contact Dighton Police Station at 508-669-6711 for more information.
- Burning season is January 15, 2016 through May 1, 2016. Permits may be obtained at Dighton Fire Station, 300 Main Street, for \$10.00. Please make checks payable to the Town of Dighton (checks only).
- There is a winter parking ban in effect from November 1 thru April 1 of each year. No parking is allowed on any street during this time. The police department is currently reminding residents in advance of any inclement weather.
- Landfill Stickers available for 2016. Available at the transfer station during regular hours on Tuesdays and Saturdays. Payment by check only at transfer station. Make checks payable to Town of Dighton for \$10.00. Also available at the selectmen's office. Registration is required for the vehicle being permitted. Stickers are not transferable.
