

BOARD OF SEWER COMMISSIONS – MINUTES 2021
August 02, 2021

PUBLIC HEARING TO SET FY 2021 SEWER RATES

Meeting opened at 5:00 P.M.

Present: Paul Joly, Thomas Ferry, Robert Woods, Superintendent Harold Gracia and Dianne Curtis.

Nancy Goulart was present for the public discussion section. Her residence is connected to sewer and she is a member of the Board of Assessors.

After some discussion regarding the future needs of the pump stations, the following took place: Thomas Ferry motioned, with the exception of Aquaria LLC., to increase the sewer base rate by of \$5.00 per unit for each of the billing periods in Fiscal Year 2022; Paul Joly stepped down and seconded the motion; Robert Woods voted nay. Motion passes by a majority.

Rates for Sewer Billings FY 2022 (Aug. 2021 & Feb. 2022):

- 1.) Raising the Residential base from \$120.00 to \$125.00 and the sewer usage rate remains the same at .026 per cubic foot.
- 2.) Raising the Large Industry from \$165.00 to \$170.00, and the usage fee remains the same at .058 per cubic foot of wastewater discharge.
- 3.) Raising the Small Industry from \$165.00 to \$170.00 and the usage fee remains the same at .051 per cubic foot.
- 4.) Raising Commercial from \$130.00 to \$135.00 and the usage fee remains the same at .028 per cubic foot.
- 5.) Raising the Municipal from \$130.00 to \$135.00 and the usage fee remains the same at .028 per cubic foot.

Aquaria Desalination plant based on discharge readings proportionate to Dighton Flow + TSS + BOD


Residential users will continue to be given a 20% discount for outside usage and be charged 80% of water usage; all other users will be charged 100% of water usage.

All fees collected by the Sewer Enterprise are used to operate and maintain the current sewer system.




